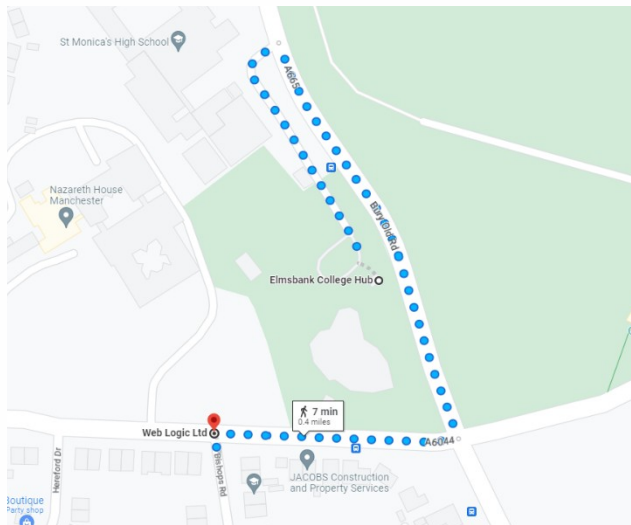

From Bishops Road turn right onto Scholes Lane. At the cross roads turn left onto Bury Old Road.

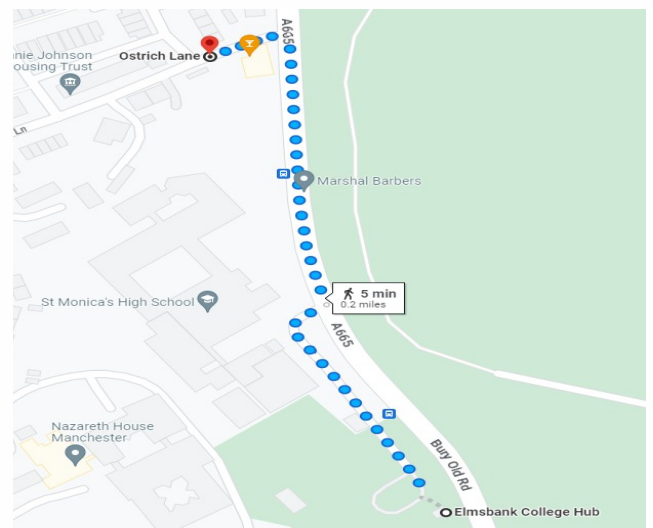
You will come to a set of locked green gates on the left hand side – if you ring 0161 6740249 and speak to the college office a member of staff will open the gate.

From Ostrich Lane turn right onto Bury Old Road

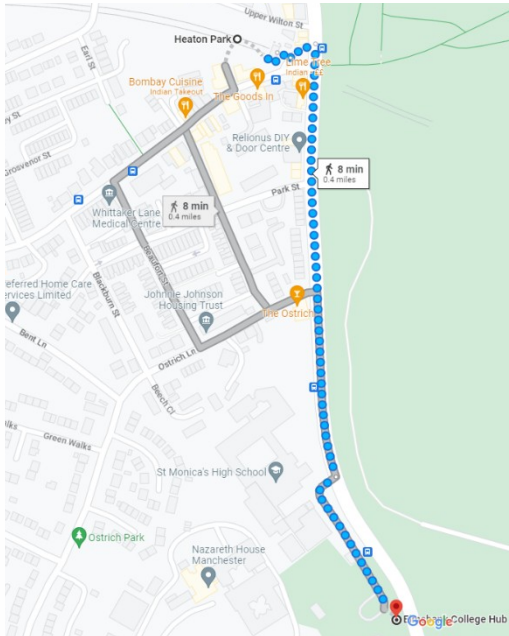
Walk down Bury Old Road until you see St Monica's on the right hand side.
